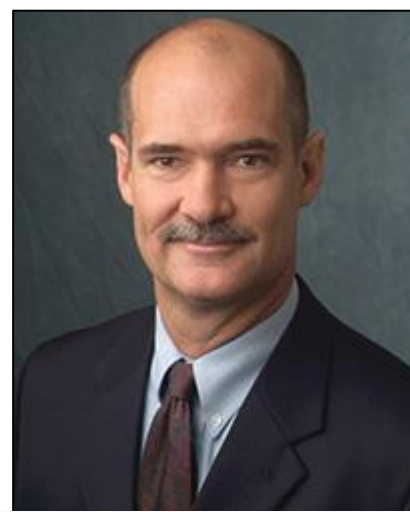




“This spring and summer have reminded water utilities that we provide the most essential public service – delivering safe and reliable water to our communities.
