Rex Hunt:

The antidegradation regulations found in the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards protect designated existing uses of surface water bodies from water quality degradation by wastewater discharges. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) typically performs an evaluation of the potential for water quality degradation during the permitting process for Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) permits. In 2020, there were two permitting actions that ultimately may affect how the TCEQ evaluates antidegradation in the future. In both cases, Protestants argued that the TCEQ's evaluation of antidegradation was flawed. Both cases are still in process. The first case was in Dripping Springs, Texas, for a new discharge permit. The other case was the Port of Corpus Christi for a brine discharge permit. The Dripping Springs case is currently in appeal in District Court. The State Office of Administrative Hearings proposed denial of the Port of Corpus Christi permit. The TCEQ is still considering whether to deny the permit. Ultimately, these cases may force the TCEQ to rethink antidegradation rules and/or implementation.
