#### **Business Meeting:**

- Vice-President Patel opened the meeting, welcomed guests and thanked the Trinity River Authority (TRA) for hosting and the sponsors.

- Approved the September 13, 2019 Meeting Minutes.
- Informed attendees about the future meetings this year thru July 2020.
  - Ray Longoria with FNI welcomed everyone to attend the Jan 2021 meeting in Corpus Christi.



## Chris Pasch:

- TDS Committee [WEAT, TACWA and WateReuse Texas] Update: discussing Harmonic Mean Flow and alternatives with TCEQ and working on scheduling a meeting in December with TCEQ.
- WEAT Permit Limit Working Group: Intent of the group is to work with TCEQ to identify other ways to express permit limits that are protective of the environment and not needlessly stringent. Permit limits for municipal wastewater treatment plants have become more stringent over time; however, no consideration has been given whether the averaging method used in TPDES permit development is appropriate for stringent limits that approach zero. In addition, an increasing number of permittees are facing the prospect of stringent nutrient limits and procedures are needed to determine the most appropriate way to express nutrient permit limits. TCEQ's current practice of requiring demonstration of compliance with permit limits, such as daily average concentration and load limits is unnecessarily inflexible and not appropriate to demonstrate compliance with stringent permit limits.

## Janet Sims:

- 312 Biosolids Rule: Published and open for comments. Comments are due on November 26. There will be a hearing on this on November 19<sup>th</sup> in Austin.
- Draft General Permit for Water Treatment Plant Discharges for conventional plants. TCEQ is seeking comments, but they will not respond to the comments but will consider them. Comments are due December 6<sup>th</sup>. The intent of this action is to reduce the workload of TCEQ.
- Charles McGuire with EPA mentions to Leonard Levine that the EPA is having difficulty in distributing grant funds. If interested in the grant funds contact Charles McGuire with the EPA.

# Julie Nahrgang:

- State Legislative Update: State voted on Proposition 8 in November and it passed. This allows the state to move money from the rainy day fund to the Flood Infrastructure Fund.
- National Defense Authorization Act making its way through the US House and Senate. There
  are pieces of PFAS legislation in the ACT. WEF and NACWA have asked members to contact
  their Representatives/Senators and ask that PFAS be included to ask EPA to do more
  scientific research.
- Regulatory Front: A Pretreatment Stakeholder Meeting coming up on January 23, 2020. A Stakeholder Meeting on December 5<sup>th</sup> over the Oil & Gas Discharge Bill under the TPDES Permit.
- Federal Blending Rule Package should see around the first of the year (2020).
- Water ReUse Action Plan: EPA is taking comments. Comments are due December 16.
- WOTUS Update: big picture, the repeal will not substantial change the TCEQ permits.
