Chris Pasch:

TDS Coalition Update:

- Received feedback from TCEQ with a request for information on other states' use of harmonic mean flow. A meeting of the TDS Committee will be scheduled soon and review response to TCEQ.
- Have been in touch with EPA Headquarters regarding development of criteria for dissolved salts. EPA is developing the work plan for FY 2019, will know details in September.
- Have been in touch with EPA Headquarters regarding use of temporary standard for dissolved salts. EPA has made the temporary standards process accessible via an online tool. EPA presented at NACWA Utility Leadership Conference; update to TACWA to come.

Mark Perkins:

The TCEQ Surface Water Quality Monitoring Guidance Advisory Work Group is having a meeting on August 24. The purpose of this work group is to provide input on the 2018 Guidance for Assessing and Reporting Surface Water Quality in Texas (Guidance). The Guidance includes procedures for evaluating surface water quality data which is used to develop the Texas Integrated Report of Surface Water Quality for Clean Water Act Sections 305(b) and 303(d), including the 303(d) List of Impaired Waters.

Julie Nahrgang:

Nothing to update on the legislative topic.

Federal Regulatory Update: Not expecting any changes with EPA Region 6 due to the change in the EPA Administrator. New blending rule is expecting in late 2018 or 2019.

Texas Regulatory Update: We have a concept memo on the 312 Biosolids Rule. Comment period to open up on November 2nd and close on December 5th of this year. It is expected to be adopted in May 2019.
